The Gabe Giardina Golden Ram Prospect Camps are open to any and all entrants (limited only by number, age, grade level, and/or gender).

The camps/clinic listed here are operated by Albany State University coaches in their personal capacity and Albany State University solely provides the facilities for these activities. These activities are not sponsored by the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia or Albany State University and none of these entities assume any responsibility for injury or damages to person or property arising out of any occurrence during these activities.

State Exemption Notice: 591-1-1-.46(1)(b)(1): Programs which are owned and operated by any department or agency of state, county, or municipal government. This includes, but is not limited to, the customary school day, as defined in Georgia law, and before and/or after school programs in public schools operated by the public school system and staff with school system employees and recreation programs operated by city or county parks and recreation departments and staff with city or county employees. NOTE: Exemption approval means this program is not licensed as a child care learning center and is not required to be licensed. Therefore, the program is not required to comply with the Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning rules for child care learning centers. Bright from the Start does not regulate or routinely inspect this program and would only monitor the program to determine or verify compliance with exemption criteria and requirements. The facility must meet all local requirements, such as complying with building, zoning, and fire requirement

Camp Information:

- For ALL Positions
- Please designate one position during registration.
- Camp includes a workout with the Albany State Football Coaching Staff.
- Participants should bring their own cleats and workout gear. No pads or helmets will be required for this camp. QBs are encouraged to bring their own ball.
- Participants will be issued a storage facility (e.g. locker) to store gear. Please refrain from bringing excess money or electronics to camp. Campers will not be allowed to share storage facilities.

• COVID 19 UPDATE

- Special steps have been taken to ensure the safety of campers and staff, and applying to CDC and State of Georgia regulations. These are included but not limited to:
 - Limited spots at each position
 - Verbal symptom screenings
 - Temperature scanning
 - Availability of hand sanitizer
 - Elimination of shared contact surfaces
 - Any camper exhibiting a temperature greater than 100.4 degrees or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 will be asked to leave the camp.
- Registration: To ensure a contactless registration, all registration MUST be performed through our website (<https://football.albanystatesportscamps.com/prospect-camps.cfm>)
- ONLY CAMPERS will be allowed to enter the registration and camp areas. Parents are encouraged to stay in their vehicles.
